- Roles
- Opportunities
- Abilities
- Possessions

#### For Whom

- Fellow believers
- Those around us
- Those under our charge
- Those God intends us to bless

# Basic Exegesis

## Oikonomos (οἰκονόμος)

- Steward, Household-manager, Servant-manager
- Slave in charge of a household (oikos, οἰκος)
  - Think extended social and economic unit
  - Think (a) church as God's household

## Structure of Stewardship

Luke 12:42-45 "Who then is the faithful wise **manager** whom the master will put in charge over his servants to give them their food allowance at the right time? <sup>43</sup> Blessed is that slave whom his master will find so doing when he comes back. <sup>44</sup> Truly I say to you that he will put him in charge of all his possessions. <sup>45</sup> But if that slave should say to himself, 'My master is taking a long time to return,' and he begins to beat the male slaves and the female slaves and to eat and drink and get drunk, ...

## Stewardship of Abilities

■ 1 Peter 4:9-11Be hospitable to one another without complaining. 10 Just as each one has received a gift, use it for serving one another, as good stewards of the varied grace of God. <sup>11</sup> If anyone speaks, let it be as the oracles of God; if anyone serves, let it be as by the strength that God provides, so that in all things God will be glorified through Jesus Christ,

## Stewardship of Knowledge

1 Corinthians 3:21-4:22 So then, let no one boast in people. For all things are yours, <sup>22</sup> whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or things present or things to come, all things are yours, <sup>23</sup> and you are Christ's, and Christ is God's. Thus let a person consider us as servants of Christ and stewards of God's mysteries. <sup>2</sup> In this case, moreover, it is sought in stewards that one be found faithful.

#### Stewardship as a leadership role

Titus 1:5-8 | left you behind in Crete, in order that what remains may be set in order and you may appoint elders in every town, ... it is necessary for the overseer to be blameless as God's steward, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not addicted to wine, not violent, not greedy for dishonest gain, 8 but hospitable,

# Basic Implications

Stewardship is not about saving so much as using.

We are stewards of just about any role, opportunity, or ability we might have. What we have been given is to bless the community we find ourselves it. These communities come in various sizes, sometimes up to the whole human race.
